



### Donor Sperm Information

Michigan Center for Fertility and Women's Health recommends ordering prepared IUI specimens. These specimens have been washed at the cryobank and are ready for insemination. After the patient has ordered the specimens, they are sent to our facility frozen in liquid nitrogen. We will then transfer the specimen(s) to our tanks for storage. We will thaw the donor specimen(s) according to the cryobank's protocol and remove one drop to assess for count and motility in our laboratory. The remaining specimen is placed into a sterile conical tube and is kept warm for the insemination.

**Please call 586)576-0431 on cycle day 1, so a nurse can review with you the required testing prior to the procedure.**

#### Donor Selection Steps:

1. Choose a cryobank and a donor.
2. Order specimen(s). Have them sent to our office at:

3. Call our office and notify us of the following:
  - a. The cryobank and the donor specimen number.
  - b. The number of specimens ordered.
  - c. The date and day the specimen(s) will be delivered to our office.  
We recommend delivery on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday.  
Mornings are preferred.

#### Insemination Fees:

\$100 laboratory charge, this includes storage in liquid nitrogen, thawing, and assessing for count and motility.
